

Privacy Policy - General Information

This statement will inform you of the processing and handling of personal data by the company EGE, spol. s r.o., IČO: 15771695, with seat at Novohradská 397/34, 370 01 České Budějovice.

Any handling of personal data is governed by Act No. 101/2000 Coll., The Personal Data Protection Act and Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) and other legislation in force in the Czech Republic. EGE, spol. s r.o. is the controller and, at the same time, the processor of personal data within the meaning of the aforementioned Act and Regulation.

Collecting your personal information:

- We may collect your personal information for purposes arising from a business or other relationship with you or your employer and, to a limited extent, to protect EGE's property and the health of employees and other visitors to the site of the controller.
- We mainly collect your personal information directly from you, or from public databases, social networks, or from HR agencies.
- We process your data in a systematic manner including both documentary and electronic processing, the processing activities are controlled by internal documentation and are subject to due care in the field of security, i.e. access to your personal data is limited to a certain group of authorized persons.

The data we collect about you is for the following processing purposes:

- a) the performance of business and entrepreneurial activities,
- b) the protection of EGE's assets and the health of employees.

Personal information may include your first and last name, title, job position, contact e-mail and telephone, education and training information; in the case of camera system recording also your portrait.

Recording from the camera system is made to clarify any incidents happening in the premises and as a so-called legitimate interest of the controller (protection of property, life and health).

Selected personal data may only be transmitted in the event of a legal obligation on the part of state authorities, as well as external trainers, health insurance companies, business partners and service providers.

We take reasonable steps to ensure that personal information is accurate, complete, and up to date.
